



Some State Library of Florida resources were funded under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act from the <u>Institute of Museum</u> and <u>Library Services</u>. Florida's LSTA program is administered by the Department of State's <u>Division of Library and Information Services</u>.

For FY2021-22, the percentage of total costs for the State Library and Statewide Resource Sharing program financed with federal money is 66%; the federal dollar amount to be spent on the program is \$1,656,577. This program does not receive any non-governmental funding.
