- You will receive an email notice when your request is accepted.

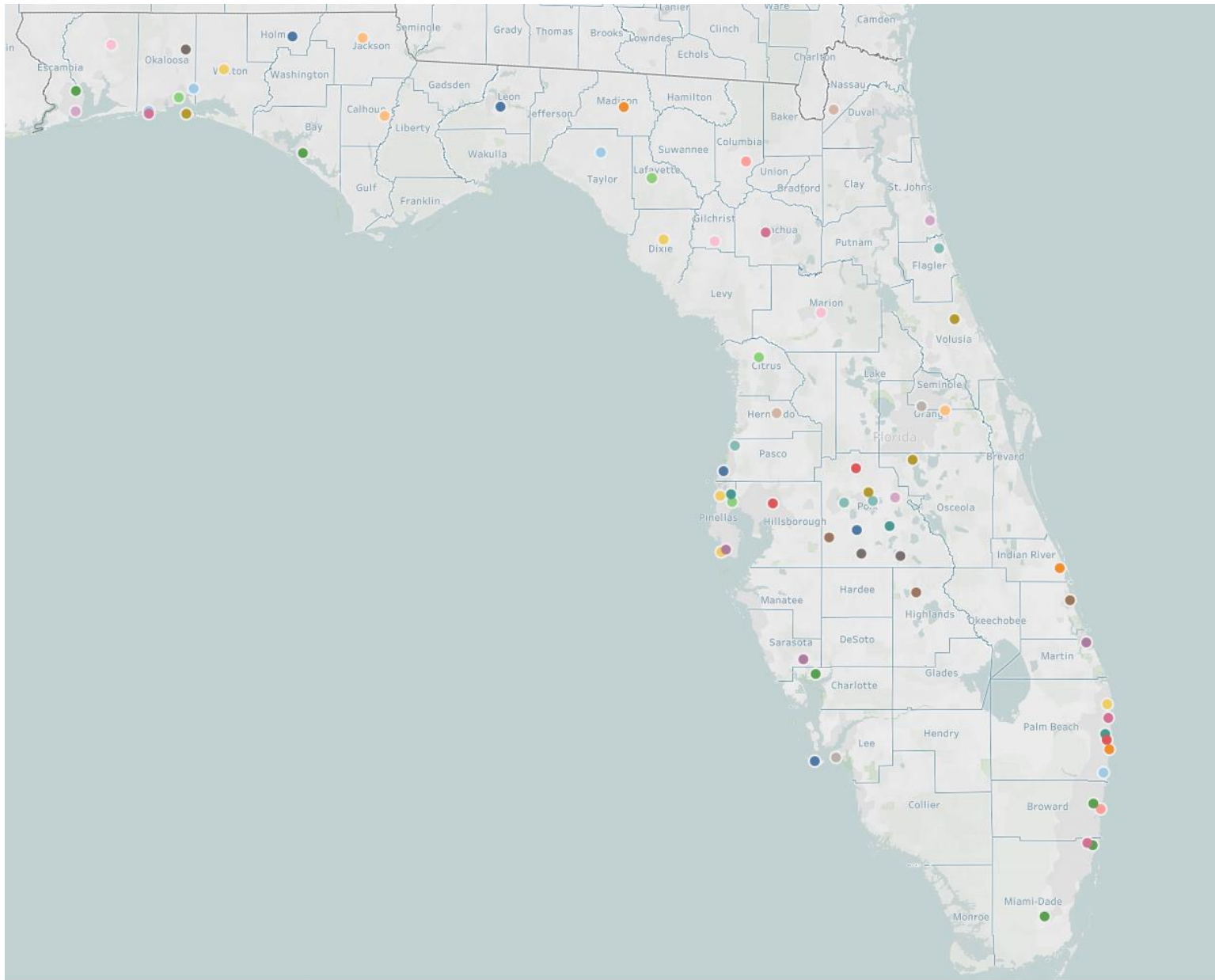
