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# What is a 3PVRO?

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## SECTION ONE



A 3PVRO is not the same as a VRA.  
Different governing laws and regulations apply.

# Activity – Collecting Applications

## 3PVRO

- Any person or entity who **collects one or more** paper voter registration applications once or more often:
  - Private individuals
  - Non-profit corporations
  - Political organizations
  - Other groups
- Reference: s. 97.0575, Fla. Stat., and Rule 1S-2.042, F.A.C.

## NOT A 3PVRO

- Only distributes blank applications
- Only collects applications from spouse, child or parent
- Is an employee or agent of:
  - Division of Elections
  - Supervisor of Elections
  - Any office that issues driver licenses or state identification cards
  - Voter Registration Agencies (VRAs) designated by federal or state laws

# Activity – Helping People Register

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- 3PVRO requirements **do not apply** when the voter submits their application directly through the official online voter registration website [Register to Vote Florida.gov](https://www.Register to Vote Florida.gov), the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' online renewal system, or directly to a Supervisor of Elections' office
- 3PVRO requirements **do apply** if a person or entity collects printed or paper form from voter using [Register to Vote Florida.gov](https://www.Register to Vote Florida.gov) or downloadable form ([English PDF](#)/ [Español PDF](#)), or any other website, and is not otherwise a spouse, child or parent

# What to do as a 3PVRO?

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## SECTION THREE

# Fiduciary Duty – s. 97.0575, Fla. Stat.

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(3)(a) A third-party voter registration organization that collects voter registration applications serves as a fiduciary to the applicant, ensuring that any voter registration application entrusted to the organization, irrespective of party affiliation, race, ethnicity, or gender, must be promptly delivered to the division or the supervisor of elections in the county in which the applicant resides within 14 days after the application was completed by the applicant, but not after registration closes for the next ensuing election. If a voter registration application collected by any third-party voter registration organization is not promptly delivered to the division or supervisor of elections in the county in which the applicant resides, the third-party voter registration organization is liable for the following fines:

1. A fine in the amount of \$50 for each application received by the division or the supervisor of

# Duties – When Collecting Paper Applications

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- Know the law and rules
- Register as a 3PVRO if collecting applications
- Obtain blank applications with assigned 3PVRO number
- Timely submit collected voter registration applications:
  - No later than the registration deadline for upcoming elections or within 14 days of applicant completing application, whichever is earlier
  - To county in which voter resides
- Include 3PVRO number
- Date the backside of collected applications

# 3PVRO Duties – Update Information with Division

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- Officer(s) changes
- Registered agent changes
- Registration agent changes
- Contact information changes
- Status changes – termination or closing of activity

Notify the Division of Elections immediately,  
so that records and public website are current.

# What constitutes a violation or non-compliance?

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## SECTION FOUR

# Key Non-Compliance Activities

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- Failure to register as a 3PVRO
- Failure to place unique 3PVRO identifier on back of collected application(s)
- Failure to date back of collected application(s)
- Failure to timely return collected application(s)
  - No later than 14 days after date completed by voter (or date collected if voter does not date application) or
  - By registration deadline (book closing) for an upcoming election, whichever is earlier

# Primary responsibilities of 3PVRO registration agent

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- Submit application:
  - To the county in which the applicant resides
  - No later than 14 days from date of application or date collected or no later than registration deadline



# Consequences for Voter ...

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If application is untimely submitted or never submitted by 3Pvro:

- New voter misses deadline to register
- Voter not able to vote
- Voter is not able to change party affiliation in time to vote for party race(s) in primary election
- Voter encounters problems voting by mail or at the polling place during Early Voting or Election Day

# Consequences for 3PVRO . . .

Untimely return – more than 14 days after date signed or collected or bookclosing, whichever is sooner

Potential Fine \$50/app

Willful - \$250



Untimely return – after book closing for most recent state or local election

Potential Fine \$100/app

Willful - \$500



Failure to return

Potential Fine \$500/app

Willful - \$1000

# Consequences for 3PVRO (cont'd.)

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MAXIMUM FINE /Calendar  
Year -\$50,000

Secretary of State Referral to  
Attorney General  
upon reasonable belief that  
violation has occurred

# Criminal Violation/Fine

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- Any 3PVRO that alters a voter's application without person's knowledge and consent is liable for \$1,000 fine per application altered if convicted under s. 104.012, Fla. Stat.

- Process requests for blank voter registration forms (if volume is 10,000 or more, refer request to DOE)
- Write or stamp 3PVRO ID number on reverse side of applications BEFORE distribution
