

Voter Extract Disk File Layout

(Updated May 2023)

Content

The extract files are created monthly in tab-delimited ASCII text file format and contain:

• Official voter registration information (active and inactive registered voters only). This information is extracted from the Florida Voter Registration System (FVRS). FVRS contains the 'official list' of registered voters in the State. The information in the monthly disk reflects voters (active and inactive) registered officially as of the end of the prior month. Confidential and/or exempt information IS NOT included. See e.g., Section 119.071, Fla. Stat.; Section 97.0585, Fla. Stat.). All information on registered voters who are participants in the Attorney General's Address Confidentiality Program pursuant to 741.401 – 741.465, Fla. Stat., is also not included. Pre-registered voters are also not included.

Unofficial voting history information:

- o The unofficial voting history corresponds to what was recorded by the county under the voter ID associated with the voter at the time of voting.
- o All unofficial voting history (state and local) after 2006 is included in the county file where the voter is currently registered. Some of that history may have occurred in prior county of residence/registration.

NOTICE: As with any records, discrepancies may appear to exist, or data entry or administrative errors may exist and/or have been addressed since the end of the prior month. Please see contact information below.

How to Open Files:

• The disk contains two zipped (compressed) folders. One folder consists of 67 county voter registration files the other consists of 67 county voting history files. The files are in tab-delimited ASCII text. To unzip folder and access file(s), open the zipped folder and drag the file(s) to a new location. File(s) can then be opened using a wide variety of text, spreadsheet, or database applications, including MS Access, MS Excel, Open Office, MySQL, and Oracle.
