- **Qualifications:** You must be a United States citizen, a Florida resident, a county resident, and at least 18 years old. You may pre-register at 16 or 17 years old, but you cannot vote until you are 18). If you have been convicted of a felony, or if a court has found you to be mentally incapacitated as to your right to vote, you cannot register or vote until your right to vote is restored. **If you do not meet any one of these qualifications, do not complete this form.** For information on felony voting rights, visit Division of Elections" webpage - dos.myflorida.com/elections/felon
- **How to Register:** 1. Register online or complete and print a form at (registrarse para votar en línea or complete e imprima el formulario) at [RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov](https://registertovoteflorida.gov) 2. Submit a paper application by mail or in person at any Supervisor of Elections' office, office that issues driver licenses, voter registration agency (public assistance office, center for independent living, office serving persons with disabilities, public library, or armed forces recruitment office) or the Division of Elections. (Supervisor of Elections' mailing addresses are on back of form). 3. If you provide a third-party voter registration organization (3PVRO) your application, it might not be delivered within the 10 days or by the registration deadline. You may choose instead to deliver in person or by mail your application to your Supervisor of Elections or register online. If you give your application to the 3PVRO to deliver, the 3PVRO must give you a receipt. To find out if your application was received, contact your Supervisor of Elections, or check your voter status at <https://registration.elections.myflorida.com/CheckVoterStatus>
- **When to Register:** The deadline to register to vote is 29 days before any election. You can update your registration record at any time. Your Supervisor of Elections will let you know if your application is incomplete or denied and the reason why. If accepted, a **Voter Information Card** will be mailed to you.

- **Identification (ID):** 1. To register or to update a registration, you must provide a current and valid Florida driver license (FL DL#) or Florida identification card number (FL ID#) or last four digits of your Social Security number (SSN) to register or to update your registration. 2. If you have never been issued a FL DL or ID card or SSN, special requirements apply before you vote for the 1st time, contact your Supervisor of Elections. **Political Party Affiliation:** Florida is a closed primary election state. To vote for party races in the primary election, you must be registered with the party no later than 29 days before that election. All voters can vote in a primary election on any issue, nonpartisan race, and a race where the candidates will face no opposition in the General Election. - **Notice:** Voter information is public, including phone number and email address. The following is not: FL DL#, FL ID#, SSN, where you registered to vote, and whether you declined to register or update your voter registration record at a voter registration agency. The signature may view but not copied.
