For Fiscal Year 2024-25, the percentage of total costs for the Florida Library Youth Program and the Library Data and Statistics Program financed with federal money is 67%; the federal dollar amount to be spent on the Florida Library Youth Program is \$255,254 and the federal dollar amount to be spent on the Library Data and Statistics Program is \$110,969. These programs do not receive any non-governmental funding.

The Florida Library Youth Program and the Library Data and Statistics Program are funded under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. Florida's LSTA program is administered by the Department of State's Division of Library and Information Services.
